Businessman, Philanthropist Morsani Hosted by Sanibel Captiva Trust Co.; Discusses New Book

In his new book, "To Be Frank: the American Dream in Business and Life," businessman and philanthropist Frank Morsani tells the story of a most unlikely journey.

It took him from a Dust Bowl-era home in Arkansas to status as one of the top auto dealership owners in the country, as well as Chairman of the Board of the United States Chamber of Commerce, working hand-in-hand with three U.S. Presidents as a champion of small businesses.

Morsani, also a Navy veteran, shared his thoughts in a town hall style program Tuesday, Feb. 23 at The Sanctuary Golf Club. The Sanibel Captiva Trust Company Founder and Chairman Al Hanser served as host, posing 10 questions to his longtime friend whose life experience in business and the community has affected change from the national to local levels.

"He never gave up on the American dream and is an inspiration to us all," said Hanser.

Morsani wrote his book to demonstrate to young people "they can be all they want to be" by hard work and determination. His goal in "To Be Frank" is to inform, educate and inspire. He underscores that education is a continuum: To paraphrase Winston Churchill, "never, never, never, ever give up." Any "student of life" will enjoy the anecdotes and pearls of wisdom in this book.

"It was not an easy decision to write the book," said Morsani, "and education is a continuum evolved into a major part of its message."

At 84, Morsani is still hard at work and proclaims, "The American Dream is alive and well." For the past three decades he has served as keynote speaker on college campuses and for national and international trade associations, having spoken throughout the United States, Europe and Asia. "It has been fun to speak on college campuses," he admitted.
